New Year Devotions

I always greet the New Year with a cordial welcome. At home, I am glad to sweep up the last of the Christmas tree needles, clear out the wrappings and clutter, carefully put away the Nativity scene and ornaments until next December. In my church study, I am happy to turn the calendar to a fairly clean page and begin looking forward to the Shandon rituals on the horizon: the Valentines' dinner, the chili cook-off, Youth Sunday, Lenten worship and joyful Easter services, as well as a host of new initiatives in the planning stages. I like to welcome the New Year with a clean, fresh burst of energy and excitement, both at home and work.

I am also ever mindful that New Year's Day is but just one annual beginning among several. May's graduations will be called commencements marking new chapters in the lives of graduates. For all practical purposes, the beginning of the school year and the church's Rally Day come August are more of a big beginning than New Year's Day. And the Christian year, of course, begins with the first Sunday of Advent at the end of November when we mark the life and min-

istry of Jesus anew. When you think about it, New Year's is just the beginning of a whole series of annual beginnings!

With this awareness, I recognize that my devotional life shifts and changes and takes new forms as the seasons bring on this variety of beginnings. Along with daily prayers and blessings, Shandon's



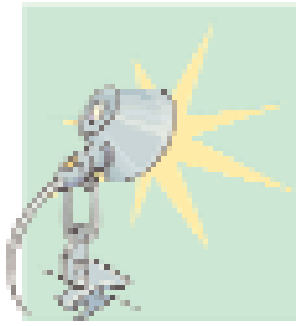
wonderful Advent devotional book carried me through last month with your thoughtful reflections. In the spring I'll turn toward a form of Lenten discipline of study. Summer usually takes me into a Celtic sort of spirituality and appreciation of those "thin places" where God can be encountered from a mountain vista or along the seashore. In the fall I typically open my well-worn *Earth Prayers From Around the World*, a wonderful collection of poems and prayers.

Throughout the year each beginning, it seems, finds new ways to worship and to listen for God.

In *Listening to Your Life: Daily Devotions with Frederick Buechner*, the devotion for January 1st fits any one of these annual beginnings. "There is no event so commonplace but that God is present within it, always hiddenly, always leaving you room to recognize him or not to recognize him, but all the more fascinatingly because of that. If I were called upon to state in a few words the essence of everything I was trying to say both as a novelist and as a preacher, it would be something like this: Listen to your life. See it for the fathomless mystery that it is. In the boredom and pain of it no less than in the excitement and gladness: touch, taste, smell your way to the holy and hidden heart of it because in the last analysis all moments are key moments, and life itself is grace."

As you listen to your life, I pray you will find hope and peace and happiness in this whol year of new beginnings.

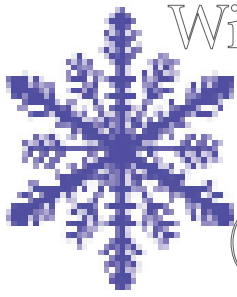



Regular Youth Schedule

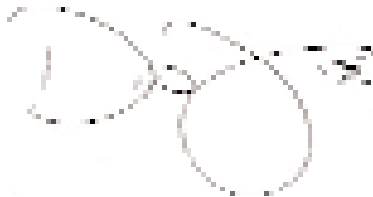
Youth Parents,

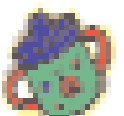
Youth Choirs Rehearsals Resume January 9th! New Choir Members are Welcome!

Update on the Presbyterian Committee on Congregational Song

The Presbyterian Committee on Congregational Song has been working two years on the next hymn/song resource for the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.).

Among other things, the Committee has:

- examined almost 4,000 items submitted during our open submission period
- combed through the contents of the 1990 Presbyterian Hymnal, the 1972 Worshipbook, and the 1955 Hymnbook
- thoroughly examined 19 other hymnals published since the 1990 Presbyterian Hymnal
- examined collections of contemporary praise and worship music
- examined collections of songs from Christian communities around the world
- written statements on language and on our theological vision for this project.

The Committee has a few items left on their to-do list, including:

- continue sorting through the possibilities
- add to and refine our tentative content list
- organize the material
- develop indexes.

The timeline on these items is:

- content will be finalized by the 2012 General Assembly in Pittsburgh
- new resources will be available in fall 2013.
